

WORSHIP DIRECTOR- JOB DESCRIPTION

ACCOUNTABILITY

- Answers to the pastors and elders

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must display a passionate love of Jesus
- Must have training or extensive experience in music
- Must be a skilled musician who is able to play instruments
- Must be a gifted worship leader who is able to guide the congregation into worship
- Must be able to interact with other church leaders in a humble and respectful way

DUTIES

The role of the Worship Director will be primarily to oversee, coordinate, produce and participate in all aspects of our music ministries.

This includes:

- 1. Overseeing the planning of the music for our church services
- 2. Choosing songs for our playlists that are Biblically accurate and musically appropriate for congregational worship
- 3. Choosing and training musicians and technicians who are capable and faithful in their service.
- 4. Overseeing all aspects of the Sunday morning presentations (i.e. ProPresenter, videos, sound . . . etc)
- 5. Producing special events (such as Christmas or Easter services . . . etc)

Depending on the skill set of the person that is hired, additional duties will be added that correspond with his/her gifts and talents.

REQUIRED HOURS OF WORK

Generally, 40 hours a week, but will be available to work extra hours as needed in the ministry.
